Admission: Exhibitor truck/trailer and maximum of 2 occupants enter grounds for free, but *all other occupants in the vehicle pay a \$10.00 gate admission fee.* **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Passes will be issued at the time of entry for one Truck/Trailer combo. All other vehicles are to be parked in the general parking locations outside the fairgrounds. Security staff will coordinate equipment drop-off after which vehicle will exit the fairgrounds and park in the general parking area.

Novice (18 and older)

Class Description: The Novice Division is designed for beginner riders who are new to equestrian competition and/or the sport of Extreme Cowboy Racing. The purpose of the Novice Division is to provide competition that is fair to all beginner riders. Novice riders are allowed to ride "up" into higher Divisions of competition.

Course: The Novice course shall have 10 obstacles plus overall Horsemanship and time points

Obstacles: Shall be rated 1 to 3

Class Fee: \$25.00

Payout: 100% of entry fees plus added money

Intermediate

Class Description: An intermediate rider is an individual who is ready to move out of the Novice division but is not yet ready to compete in the Non-Pro division. A rider in this division has had some competitive experience in other equestrian sports.

Course: The intermediate course shall contain 13 obstacles plus overall Horsemanship and time points

Obstacles: Shall be rated 1 to 4

Class Fee: \$25.00

Payout: 100% of entry fees plus added money

Non-Pro

Class Description: A non-pro rider is an individual who has experience as a rider but does not receive any form of compensation for riding or training horses, ponies or mules. This definition applies to all riders aged 18 and over, except a youth rider with parental permission.

Course: The non-pro course shall contain 13 obstacles plus overall Horsemanship and time points

Obstacles: Shall be rated 1 to 5

Class Fee: \$25.00

Payout: 100% of entry fees plus added money
