NOTE: All exhibitors must provide with entries, insurance company name, policy number, expiry date and proof of at least \$2 million liability coverage.

Limited parking on the grounds, parking stickers for livestock vehicle must appear in the truck or trailer window, or vehicle will be towed at the expense of the owner.

Substitutions when an animal is unfit to show. Three exhibitors & 24 exhibits per breed or only 50% of the prize money will be paid. Classes 1 to 4 exhibits per breeding unit are restricted to a maximum of 2 classes. There is no restriction on multiple exhibits in classes 6 to 10. Max. total eligible animals from a breeding unit is 12 exhibits to allow a 4-H member to show their current animal in an open class. A copy of the Code of Ethics for Dairy Shows will be available from the Committee Chairperson as reference if required.

SECTION 21: HOLSTEIN (Junior Show)

1. Female - Mar. 1/16 to Jun. 1/16
2. Female - Dec. 1/15 to Feb. 28/16
3. Female - Sept. 1/15 - Nov. 30/15
4. Female - Jun. 1/15- Aug. 31/15
5. Female - Mar. 1/15- May 31/15
6. Female - Dec. 1/14- Feb. 28/15
7. Female - Sept. 1/14- Nov. 30/14
8. Junior Breeder's Herd of 3 - bred & owned by exhibitor, must have been in 1 previous class. Ribbons only. Registration Certificate for each animal must show exhibitor as "breeder" & "owner" in both cases either as individual or partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be "joint owner" of an animal and/or "joint breeder" of an animal, must be from 1 farm or breeding unit.
9. Championship Show - 2 animals of each class. Ribbons.

SECTION 23: DAIRY SPECIALS

1. Pre - 4-H Showperson for non 4-H members. Calves any age, dairy or beef, male or female, must comply with health standards of fair. An adult of showperson may assist in ring. (Prizes & Ribbons).
2. Herdsmen Special: Awarded for excellence in overall presentation of exhibit for judging & viewing by the general public, special emphasis on cleanliness of animals & stalls. Cash Prize.
