NOTE: All exhibitors must provide a copy of proof of insurance with company name, policy number, expiry date and proof of at least \$2 million liability coverage either with mailed entries or when picking up numbers the day of the Fair.

All trucks and trailers must enter the grounds by Gate # 6 off Huntley Road. Due to limited space on the grounds car parking will be limited to Fair Board, handicap and assigned permit holders only. Vehicle and handicap parking will be available in Lion's Park parking lot by entrance off Huntley Road and in a lot at the corner of Huntley Road and Perth Street. Vehicles on the grounds without proper permits will be towed at the owner expense.

We have received several complaints that we are not enforcing the 38" height rule (measured at the last hairs of the mane). This rule will be strictly enforced at the current Fair. Upon complaint, a qualified person will be available to perform the measurement. If the animal is over 38", it is not a Miniature Horse and will be excused from the Miniature Show. All prizes won up to that point will be forfeited.

No one person can show with two different horses and no one horse can be shown with two different drivers in the same class.

Judging guidelines for classes will be available at the show.

All exhibitors and handlers in the ring must be properly attired in all classes.

Youth (18 years and under) wishing to compete in classes 14 and 16 to 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

Line Classes

1. Filly, Colt or Gelding 2 years and under
2. Mare 3 years and over
3. Gelding 3 years and over
4. Stallion 3 years and over
5. Champion and Reserve Champion (Ribbons only) - All entries placing 1st or 2nd in classes 1 to 4 are eligible to enter class 5

Performance Classes

6. Open Hunter, to be judged on style manners and way of going. Jumps not to exceed 18".
7. Mens Cart
8. Ladies Cart

9. Golden Age, drivers 60 years and over
10. Youth Cart, 13 to 17 years
11. Youth Cart, 7 to 12 years, must be accompanied by an adult and wear an approved helmet
12. Lead Line, child 6 years & under. Children may ride or drive. To be judged at a walk only. Rider/driver must be able to sit in the saddle/cart, hold reins without help and wear an approved helmet. No stallions.
13. Roadster, horses to be shown in a bike (two wheeled cart with stirrups and no basket), driver must wear stable colours.
14. Tandem
15. Roman Chariot, single or pair, driver to be 16 years and over
16. 4 Horse Hitch
17. Unicorn
18. Pair
19. Multiple Hitch Cones (Timed Obstacle)
20. Obstacle Driving Competition (Gambler's Choice)
21. Cones Driving Single Vehicles Only Competition (Fault and Out)
22. Barrels
