1:00 p.m. Holstein Dairy Show (includes 4-H conformation)

Note: All exhibitors must provide with entries, insurance company name, policy number, expiry date and proof of at least \$2million liability coverage.

Limited parking on the grounds, parking stickers for livestock vehicle must appear in the truck or trailer window, or vehicle will be towed at the expense of the owner.

Substitutions when an animal is unfit to show. Three exhibitors and 24 exhibits per breed or only 50% of the prize money will be paid. Classes 1 to 4 exhibits per breeding unit are restricted to a maximum of two classes. There is no restriction on multiple exhibits in classes 6 to 10. Maximum total eligible animals from a breeding unit is 12 exhibits to allow a 4-H member to show their current animal in an open class. A copy of the Code of Ethics for Dairy Shows will be available from the Committee Chairperson as reference if required.

Section 21: Holstein (Junior Show)

1. Female – Mar 1 2022 to Jul 1 2022
2. Female – Dec 1 2021 to Feb 28 2022
3. Female – Sept 1 2021 to Nov 30 2021
4. Female – Jun 1 2021 to Aug 31 2021
5. Female – Mar 1 2021 to May 31 2021
6. Female – Dec 1 2020 to Feb 28 2021
7. Female – Sept 1 2020 to Nov 30 2020
8. Junior Breeder's Herd of 3 - bred and owned by exhibitor, must have been in previous class. Ribbons only. Registration Certificate for each animal must show exhibitor as 'breeder' and 'owner' in both cases either as individual or partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be 'joint owner/ of an animal and/ or 'joint breeder' of an animal, must be from one farm or breeding unit.
9. Championship Show – 2 animals of each class. Ribbons only.

1. Herdsman Special: Awarded for excellence in overall presentation of exhibit for judging and viewing by the general public, special emphasis on cleanliness of animals and stalls. Cash Prize.
