EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. **Insurance:** All exhibitors must provide with entries insurance company name, policy number, expiry date and proof of at least \$2 million liability coverage.
2. **Stalls:** Standing \$0/day. Hitched horses eligible for stalls first. No entries accepted on telephone or in ring. Shavings not provided.
3. **Parking:** All trucks and trailers must enter the grounds by Gate # 6 off Huntley Road. Due to limited space on the grounds car parking will be limited to Fair Board handicap and assigned permit holders only. Vehicle and handicap parking will be available in Lions Park parking lot by entrance off Huntley Road and in a lot at the corner of Huntley Road and Perth Street. Vehicles on the grounds without proper permits will be towed at the expense of the owner. No campers in hitching area.
4. For all purebred animals the name, date of birth, sex, registration number, the name and registration number for the sire and dam is required on the entry form, the age will be from January 1 of the current year. Foals will be 1-year old on January 1 after birth. Purebred horses to be shown in registered classes only, except Specials and Draft Hitch classes.
5. **Registrations and transfers:** must be completed prior to making entry. All animals must be owned by exhibitor 30 days prior to the Fair. The committee will decide if the exhibitor is in the right class. Registration papers must be available.
6. The Fair authorizes that a breeding unit may show 2 animals in any 3 classes but only 1 in the balance of the breeding classes, (Class 1 to / and including 7) to be max. of 10 animals per breeding unit. All exhibits must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
